CAMP STAFF

The quarterbacks will be led by **Marietta College Head Coach Jeff Filkovski**. Filkovski has coached at both the collegiate and professional level.

Prior to joining Marietta last season, Filkovski was the offensive coordinator for Heidelberg College. Prior to leading Heidelberg he was the offensive coordinator for the Cologne Centurions of NFL Europe. The Centurions had the second-ranked offense in the league and finished 6-4.

He began his coaching career as a quarterback coach/recruiting coordinator at the College of Holy Cross from 1992-95. Filkovski also spent four years as the quarterback coach at the University of Cincinnati. During his time at Cincinnati, the Bearcat squad earned the 2002 Conference USA title.



Filkovski had an outstanding career as a quarterback at Allegheny (Pa.) College. In 1990, while being named the Football Gazette Division III Offensive Player of the Year and the Associated Press Little All American Quarterback, Filkovski led the Gators to a 13-0-1 record and the NCAA Division III National Championship.

The receivers will be led by **Marietta Wide Receiver Coach Turner Pugh** who has playing and coaching experience at the Division I level. Prior to coming to Marietta, Pugh spent the last year as a recruiting assistant at Indiana University, where he also helped coach the wide receivers. Turner Pugh is a 2004 graduate of Northern Illinois where he was a three-year letter winner as a wide out. Following his playing days he also served as a student intern for NIU in 2004.
